GOLDEN PATRICIA EXTENSION INTERSECTED

Trillium North Minerals Ltd. ("Trillium") is pleased to announce preliminary results from the 2007 drilling program at the Dorothy-Dobie Project in Pickle Lake. Hole DOR-07-005 has intersected visible gold in the western extension of the Golden Patricia Zone. The visible gold occurs in a quartz vein over a drilled width of 0.25 metres from 111.49 to 111.74 metres. True width of the visible gold zone is estimated at 0.18 metres. Photographs of the visible gold intersection will be posted on the Company's website, on November 22, 2007 at 12:00 PM EST.

Barrick Gold's Golden Patricia Mine adjoins the Dorothy Dobie Project to the east and produced 860,000 tons at a grade of 0.58 oz/ton gold between 1989 and 1997 (Lac Mineral Annual Reports 1991 to 1994, Barrick Gold Annual Reports 1995 to 1998). The mined portion of the Golden Patricia vein averaged 0.45 metres.

Trillium's 2007 drill program was designed to confirm the presence of the western extension of the Golden Patricia Vein and to aid in the building of a geological model for the property. Data from historic drilling on the property was found to be incomplete necessitating a reconnaissance drill program to aid in targeting. The current drilling has confirmed the presence of both the structure and gold mineralization.

Follow up drilling is currently being planned for early 2008 and will include drilling on the Golden Patricia Extension and four other targets identified in compilation work; the Cooper Zone and the Far West Golden Patricia Extension, as well as the Dobie and the Dorothy Zones where historic non NI 43-101 compliant gold resources occur.

The samples from hole DOR-07-005 have been selected, sealed and delivered to ALS Chemex laboratory in Thunder Bay Ontario. The fifteen samples in and around the zone have been labeled "RUSH" for assay. Upon receipt of the assay data, Trillium will immediately issue a press release disseminating the information.

Michael Thompson, P. Geo and Caitlin Jeffs, P. Geo., both qualified persons under National Instrument 43-101, have approved the technical content of this news release and will supervise the project set out above for quality control of the assaying and reporting.

Elliot Strashin, CEO, is quoted, "The results, although preliminary in nature, are extremely encouraging and confirm our belief in the exceptional potential of the property. As we await further results from the Golden Patricia Vein, Trillium is also currently drilling its Timmins Gold Project and when completed will move the same drill to our Vanguard Zinc-Copper-Gold-Silver VMS JV west of Thunder Bay, as we continue our aggressive drilling plan for 2007-8."
